A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting the use of
2 cellular telephones and other mobile communication devices
3 while driving; providing exceptions; providing definitions;
4 providing penalties; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-236 is created to read:

9

10 **31-5-236. Use of cellular telephones and other mobile**
11 **communication devices.**

13 (a) No person shall use a mobile communication device
14 while operating a motor vehicle unless the device is
15 specifically designed to allow hands-free operation and the
16 device is so used. This section shall not apply to a person
17 who is using the mobile communication device:

(i) To contact an emergency response vehicle; or

(ii) While the vehicle is lawfully parked.

(b) This section shall not apply to a person operating an emergency response vehicle while performing official duties.

(c) Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of this section shall be subject to the monetary penalties provided by W.S. 31-5-1201(b).

(d) As used in this section:

(i) "Emergency response vehicle" means any ambulance, fire department, law enforcement, highway patrol or civil defense vehicle or other vehicle used primarily for emergency purposes;

(ii) "Mobile communication device" means a cellular telephone, citizen's band radio or other device that enables a person in a motor vehicle to transmit and

1 receive audio signals to and from a person not in the motor
2 vehicle.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
