A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judicial salaries; increasing judicial  
2 salaries as specified; providing appropriations; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-110(a)(i) is amended to read:

9 **5-1-110. Salaries of judges.**

11 (a) Subject to constitutional and statutory  
12 provisions concerning when salaries can become effective,  
13 judges of the supreme court, district courts and circuit  
14 courts shall receive the following annual salaries which  
15 shall be paid in equal monthly installments on the last  
16 working day of the month:

(i) Supreme court justices shall receive an annual salary of ~~ninety-three thousand dollars (\$93,000.00)~~ one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000.00);

(a) Until such time as the salaries provided by section one of this act become effective, the following salary schedule shall apply:

(i) For supreme court justices, \$93,000.00;

(ii) For district court judges, \$83,700.00;

(iii) For circuit court judges, \$69,750.00;

(iv) For district attorneys, \$69,750.00.

(a) There is appropriated from the general fund to the supreme court three million sixteen thousand seven hundred forty-eight dollars (\$3,016,748.00) for the

1 biennium beginning July 1, 2002 to implement the salary  
2 formula for judges established under this act.

4 (b) There is appropriated from the general fund for  
5 the period beginning January 7, 2003 through June 30, 2004,  
6 to the Natrona county district attorney's office and to the  
7 Laramie county district attorney's office thirty-six  
8 thousand six hundred ninety dollars (\$36,690.00) each, to  
9 implement salary increases for district attorneys resulting  
10 from the salary formula established under this act.

12 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
