A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; providing
2 an additional year for the department of workforce services
3 to review and implement a reorganization plan; providing an
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2018(b) is amended to read:

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10 **9-2-2018. Department of workforce services created;**
11 **director appointed; structure.**

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13 (b) The administrative head of the department shall
14 be a director appointed by the governor not later than
15 April 1, 2001. The director shall prepare a plan for
16 reorganization of the agencies, programs and functions
17 specified in this section and submit it to the governor for

1 approval. The department reorganization plan, as approved,
2 shall be submitted to the joint labor, health and social
3 services interim committee of the legislature no later than
4 October 15, 2001 and made available to the public. The
5 committee shall hold at least one (1) public hearing
6 regarding the plan before the 2002 budget session of the
7 legislature convenes. The joint labor, health and social
8 services interim committee shall report to the legislature
9 by December 1, 2001, its recommendations on the plan,
10 including necessary legislation with respect to the plan.
11 The director shall review and update the department
12 reorganization plan and submit the revised plan to the
13 joint labor, health and social services interim committee
14 no later than October 15, 2002. The revised plan, as
15 approved by act of the legislature, shall be implemented
16 not later than July 1, ~~2002~~2003.

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18 **Section 2.** There is appropriated from the general fund
19 to the department of workforce services one hundred thirty-
20 six thousand five hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$136,539.00)
21 for the fiscal year July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003.

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1 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
