- 10 creating a new paragraph (v), 35-9-107(b)(ii) and
- 11 35-9-121(b)(i) and (ii) are amended to read:

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13 35-9-106. Powers and duties of council.

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15 (a) The council shall adopt rules and regulations to:

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1	(i) Establish minimum fire standards not
2	exceeding taking into consideration the standards
3	prescribed by the Uniform Fire Code, the Uniform Building
4	Code and the Uniform Mechanical Code International Code
5	Council and allowing the council on fire prevention,

Local enforcement. 4 5 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) 6 of this section a local governmental entity is authorized 7 to assume joint plan review authority with the state fire 8 9 marshal, and that entity has sole construction inspection 10 authority on the approved plans, and sole authority for 11 periodic fire and life safety inspections on state owned or 12 leased buildings. If local code provisions conflict with 13 adopted state codes, the state code prevails. The authority 14 granted to local governmental entities under subsection is subject to certification of local inspectors 15 16 as follows: 17 18 (i) If joint plan review authority is requested, 19 certification of a plan reviewer by the international 20 conference of building officials or International Code 21 Council; 22 23 (ii) If code enforcement authority for fire and 24 building codes is requested, certification of a fire

inspector or building inspector by the state fire marshal
International Code Council or the International Conference

for Building Officials;

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
