for

1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; authorizing
 2 construction of designated water projects; describing
 3 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for
 4 projects; providing restrictions relating to sales of water
 5 and operation of projects; providing appropriations;
 6 modifying project descriptions, terms of appropriations for
 7 various specified prior projects; and providing for an
 8 effective date.

17 section, subject to the general conditions specified in

24 (i) Project sponsor: Town of Alpine;

2 (ii) Project purpose: Engineering design and
3 specifications for a raw water supply system;

5 (iii) Project description: Final engineering
6 design and specifications, review of water rights, legal
7 expenses for acquiring rights-of-way and permit procurement
8 for a raw water supply system for the Town of Alpine and
9 design of appurtenances necessary for the project to
10 function in the manner intended;

11

12 (iv) Total project budget: Fifty-five thousand
13 six hundred dollars (\$55,600.00);

14

15 (v) Project loan: The state of Wyoming shall
16 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
17 through the commission for the design and specifications,
18 review of water rights, permit procurement, legal expenses
19 to cover costs of exhibits and documents necessary to
20 acquire rights-of-way of the project an amount not to
21 exceed thirteen thousand nine hundred dollars (\$13,900.00)
22 or twenty-five percent (25%) of the actual development
23 costs, whichever is less, for a term of five (5) years from
24 the date the commission determines project benefits accrue

1 to the sponsor, at an annual rate of seven and one-quarter
2 percent (7.25%);

4 (vi) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall

14 the Worland well field to other systems in the Big Horn
15 Basin, a river crossing and appurtenances necessary to make
16 the project function in the manner intended;

18 (iv) Total project budget: Eleven million
19 dollars (\$11,000,000.00);

20

21 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
22 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
23 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
24 project land procurement, construction engineering, and

1 construction of a the project an amount not to exceed five
2 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$5,500,000.00) or
3 fifty percent (50%) of the actual development costs,
4 whichever is less;

5
6 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
7 water development account I to the commission five million
8 five hundred thousand dollars (\$5,500,000.00) or as much
9 thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this
10 subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
11 subsection shall revert to water development account I on
12 July 1, 2007;

13
14 (vii) Special condition: The sponsor is
15 responsible for acquiring fifty percent (50%) of the total
16 project budget from other sources.

5 manner intended;

7 (iv) Total project budget: Three million one
8 hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$3,188,000.00);

9
10 (v) Project loan: The state of Wyoming shall
11 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
12 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
13 construction engineering, land acquisition and related
14 legal expenses, and construction of the project an amount
15 not to exceed one million five hundred ninety-four thousand
16 dollars (\$1,594,000.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the
17 actual development costs, whichever is less, for a term of
18 twenty (20) years from the date the commission determines
19 project benefits accrue to the sponsor, at an annual rate
20 of seven and one-quarter percent (7.25%);

21
22 (vi) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
23 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
24 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,

1 construction engineering, project land procurement, and
2 construction of the project an amount not to exceed one

4 (iv) Total project budget: Seven million nine
5 hundred ten thousand dollars (\$7,910,000.00);

6

7 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
8 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
9 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
10 construction engineering, project land procurement and
11 construction of the project an amount not to exceed three
12 million nine hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
13 (\$3,955,000.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the actual
14 development costs, whichever is less;

15

16 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
17 water development account I to the commission three million
18 nine hundred fifty-five thousand dollars (\$3,955,000.00) or
19 as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of
20 this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
21 subsection shall revert to water development account I on
22 July 1, 2007;

23

1 (vii) Special condition: The sponsor is
2 responsible for acquiring fifty percent (50%) of the total
3 project budget from other sources.

4

5 (f) Project - Little Snake River Small Dams and
6 Reservoirs Phase II Project:

8 (i) Project sponsor: Little Snake River
9 Conservation District;

10

11 (ii) Project purpose: Multi-purpose -
12 agriculture, recreation;

13

14 (iii) Project description: Construction of small
15 dams to impound water for livestock, wildlife and
16 recreation use;

17

18 (iv) Total project budget: Five hundred thousand
19 dollars (\$500,000.00);

20

21 (v) Project loan: The state of Wyoming shall
22 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
23 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
24 project land procurement, construction engineering and

1 construction of the project an amount not to exceed two
2 hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) or forty percent
3 (40%) of the actual development costs, whichever is less,
4 for a term of twenty-five (25) years from the date the
5 commission determines project benefits accrue to the
6 sponsor, at an annual interest rate of six percent (6%);

7

8 (vi) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
9 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
10 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
11 project land procurement, construction engineering and
12 construction of the project an amount not to exceed three
13 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) or sixty percent
14 (60%) of the actual development costs, whichever is less;

15

16 (vii) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
17 water development account I to the commission five hundred
18 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) or as much thereof as is
19 necessary to carry out the purpose of this subsection.
20 Unexpended funds appropriated under this subsection shall
21 revert to water development account I on July 1, 2007;

22

23 (viii) Special conditions:

24

1 (A) The sponsor shall deposit cash or other
2 securities valued at the full amount of the loan in an
3 escrow account, as deemed appropriate by the attorney
4 general, which names the commission as the beneficiary or
5 recipient in the event of default on the loan. Interest
6 earnings on cash or securities deposited in the escrow
7 account shall remain with the sponsor;

8

9 (B) Construction of dams and reservoirs
10 shall be limited to all or a portion of the twelve (12)
11 projects identified and recommended for construction in the
12 Little Snake River Basin Small Reservoir Development
13 Project. The sponsor shall obtain the approval of the
14 commission prior to the construction of any individual
15 facility; and

16

17 (C) The sponsor shall be responsible for
18 obtaining all permits and clearances necessary for
19 construction of the project.

20

21 (g) Project - Pinedale Intake Project:

22

23 (i) Project sponsor: Town of Pinedale;

24

1 (ii) Project purpose: Municipal and domestic
2 water supply;

3

4 (iii) Project description: Redesign and
5 construction of the town's intake located at Fremont Lake
6 to address icing conditions due to drought related lowering
7 of the lake which caused ice to encase the intake pipeline
8 and lift the submerged section of the pipeline when the
9 lake level rose in the spring and appurtenances necessary
10 to make the project function in the manner intended;

11

12 (iv) Total project budget: One hundred ninety-
13 three thousand dollars (\$193,000.00);

14

15 (v) Project loan: The state of Wyoming shall
16 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
17 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
18 construction engineering, project land procurement and
19 construction of the project an amount not to exceed ninety-
20 six thousand five hundred dollars (\$96,500.00) or fifty
21 percent (50%) of the actual development costs, whichever is
22 less, for a term of ten (10) years from the date the
23 commission determines project benefits accrue to the

1 sponsor, at an annual rate of seven and one-quarter percent
2 (7.25%);

3

4 (vi) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
5 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
6 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
7 project land procurement, construction engineering, and
8 construction of a the project an amount not to exceed
9 ninety-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$96,500.00) or
10 fifty percent (50%) of the actual development costs,
11 whichever is less;

12

13 (vii) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
14 water development account I to the commission one hundred
15 ninety-three thousand dollars (\$193,000.00) or as much
16 thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this
17 subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
18 subsection shall revert to water development account I on
19 July 1, 2006.

8 to the Town of Sinclair to comply with the Safe Drinking
9 Water Act and appurtenances necessary to make the project
10 function in the manner intended;

11

12 (iv) Total project budget: One million three
13 hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$1,345,000.00);

14

15 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
16 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
17 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
18 construction engineering, project land procurement and
19 construction of the project an amount not to exceed six
20 hundred seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars
21 (\$672,500.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the actual
22 development costs, whichever is less;

23

1 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
2 water development account I to the commission six hundred
3 seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$672,500.00) or
4 as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of
5 this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
6 subsection shall revert to water development account I on
7 July 1, 2007;

8

9 (vii) Special condition: The sponsor is
10 responsible for acquiring fifty percent (50%) of the total
11 project budget from other sources.

12

13 (j) Project - Small Water Development Projects:

15 (i) Project sponsors: Eligible public entities;

16

17 (ii) Project purpose: Multi-purpose -
18 agriculture, recreation, environmental;

19

20 (iii) Project description: Construction of small
21 dams, windmills, spring development, pipelines, etc., to
22 impound, develop and convey water for livestock, wildlife,
23 environmental and recreational purposes;

24

1 (iv) Total project budget: One million dollars
2 (\$1,000,000.00);

3

4 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
5 grant to sponsors from water development account I through
6 the commission for the design, permit procurement, project
7 land procurement, construction engineering and construction
8 of the project an amount not to exceed five hundred
9 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) or fifty percent (50%) of
10 the actual development costs, whichever is less;

11

12 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
13 water development account I to the commission five hundred
14 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) or as much thereof as is
15 necessary to carry out the purpose of this subsection. The
16 funds appropriated shall not lapse at the end of any fiscal
17 period but shall carry over until expended or reverted by
18 the legislature to water development account I;

19

20 (vii) Definition: "Small project" means a
21 project where construction costs, permit procurement,
22 construction engineering and project land procurement are
23 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or less;

24

1 (viii) Special conditions:

2

3 (A) Only projects with a total construction
4 cost of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or less are
5 eligible for funding;

6

7 (B) The commission shall conduct two (2)
8 pilot studies in two (2) separate watersheds to establish
9 eligibility criteria and administration procedures for
10 development of small projects. Once the criteria and
11 administration procedures are approved and adopted by the
12 commission, the program may be applied on a state-wide
13 basis;

14

15 (C) The commission may grant a sponsor
16 fifty percent (50%) of the construction cost of a project
17 with a maximum grant awarded a sponsor limited to twenty-
18 five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00);

19

20 (D) The project sponsors must substantiate
21 the public benefit that will be derived from proposed
22 projects;

23

1 (E) The commission may make monthly
2 progress payments for no more than fifty percent (50%) of
3 eligible monthly project expenses;

4
5 (F) An appropriate land management or
6 resource management entity must certify that the proposed
7 project will meet expectations and that appropriate
8 engineering standards, as approved by the commission, will
9 be adhered to.

10

11 (k) Project - Torrington Raw Water Project:

12

13 (i) Project sponsor: City of Torrington;

14

15 (ii) Project purpose: Raw water irrigation
16 supply;

17

18 (iii) Project description: Drilling and
19 construction of three (3) groundwater wells to irrigate
20 greenways to assist the city with complying with an
21 administrative order issued by the Environmental Protection
22 Agency regarding compliance with the Safe Drinking Water
23 Act and appurtenances necessary to make the project
24 function in the manner intended;

(iv) Total project budget: One hundred ninety-two thousand dollars (\$192,000.00);

(v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall grant to the sponsor from water development account I through the commission for the design, permit procurement, project land procurement, construction engineering, and construction of the project an amount not to exceed ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the actual development costs, whichever is less;

(vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from water development account I to the commission ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this subsection shall revert to water development account I on July 1, 2007; and

(vii) Special condition: The sponsor is responsible for acquiring fifty percent (50%) of the total project budget from other sources.

17 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
18 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
19 construction engineering, project land procurement and
20 construction of the project an amount not to exceed three
21 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) or fifty percent
22 (50%) of the actual development costs, whichever is less,
23 for a term of twenty (20) years from the date the
24 commission determines project benefits accrue to the

1 sponsor, at an annual rate of seven and one-quarter percent
2 (7.25%);

4 (vi) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
5 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
