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(c) The board shall fix a rental value on the basis 7 8 of a definite amount per acre based upon of not less than 9 fair market value of each use of the land. If the land to 10 be leased under this subsection was originally acquired by 11 the state for the benefit of the common school permanent 12 land fund, and is to be used by a Wyoming school district for the construction and maintenance of school buildings 13 14 and facilities, the board may assess an annual rental fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per acre or not less than 15 fair market value, whichever is less. 16

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18 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 21 Constitution.
