AN ACT relating to crime victims compensation; expanding the definition of "victim" to include victims of domestic terrorism as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 1-40-102(a)(ix) by creating new subparagraphs (D) and (E) is amended to read:

1-40-102. Definitions.

- (a) As used in this act:
 - (ix) "Victim" means:
- residents and who have suffered a pecuniary loss as a result of a terrorist attack in the United States, regardless of the actual victim's residency;
- victim of a crime involving terrorism occurring outside this state if:
- it occurred within this state; and
- suffered a pecuniary loss as a direct result of the act of terrorism committed in another state of the United States.
