A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to county officers; modifying the amount of
2 state payments to be made for the salary and expenses of
3 county and prosecuting attorneys and full-time assistants;
4 providing for salaries of county attorneys as specified;
5 making an appropriation; and providing for an effective
6 date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-107(a) and (f) is amended to
11 read:

13 **18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;**
14 **additional compensation prohibited; exception as to**
15 **traveling and other expenses; compensation of county**

1 **commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,**
2 **stenographers and other assistants.**

4 (a) From and after January 1, 1979, the county
5 assessor, part-time county and prosecuting attorneys,
6 part-time county attorneys, county clerk, clerk of district
7 court, county sheriff and county treasurer in their
8 respective counties shall receive not less than ten
9 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than twenty-five
10 thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) as annual salaries. From and
11 after January 1, 1983, the specified county officers shall
12 receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand
13 dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than forty thousand dollars
14 (\$40,000.00). Full-time county and prosecuting attorneys
15 shall receive not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
16 (\$35,000.00) and not more than forty-five thousand dollars
17 (\$45,000.00) as annual salaries. From and after January 1,
18 1995, the specified full-time county officers shall receive
19 an annual salary not less than ten thousand dollars
20 (\$10,000.00) nor more than fifty thousand dollars
21 (\$50,000.00). Full-time county attorneys shall receive not
22 less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) nor more
23 than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) as annual
24 salaries. Full-time county and prosecuting attorneys shall

1 receive not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
2 (\$35,000.00) nor more than sixty thousand dollars
3 (\$60,000.00) as annual salaries. From and after January 1,
4 1999, the specified full-time county officers shall receive
5 an annual salary not less than ten thousand dollars
6 (\$10,000.00) nor more than sixty thousand dollars
7 (\$60,000.00). From and after January 1, 2003, full-time
8 county attorneys shall receive not less than thirty
9 thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) nor more than ~~seventy~~
10 ~~thousand dollars (\$70,000.00)~~ eighty thousand dollars
11 (\$80,000.00) as annual salaries. From and after January 1,
12 2003, full-time county and prosecuting attorneys shall
13 receive not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
14 (\$35,000,00) nor more than ~~seventy thousand dollars~~
15 ~~(\$70,000.00)~~ eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000.00) as annual
16 salaries. Salaries shall be paid in equal monthly
17 installments. The board of county commissioners of each
18 county shall meet not later than June 1, 1978, and on or
19 before the same date each four (4) years thereafter, for
20 the purpose of setting salaries, which shall not be changed
21 during the term of each official for whom a salary is
22 determined.

1 (f) The state will pay ~~twenty thousand dollars~~
2 ~~(\$20,000.00) or~~ fifty percent (50%) of the salary of the
3 full-time county and prosecuting attorney, ~~whichever is~~
4 ~~less, per year,~~ to each qualifying county. In counties with
5 a population greater than nine thousand (9,000) the state
6 will pay ~~fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) or~~ fifty percent
7 (50%) of the salary of a full-time assistant to the county
8 and prosecuting attorney, ~~whichever is less, per year,~~ for
9 each assistant per ten thousand (10,000) population over
10 nine thousand (9,000). The state shall also pay ~~three~~
11 ~~thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)~~ five thousand dollars
12 (\$5,000.00) for expenses of the office of county and
13 prosecuting attorney for each full-time county and
14 prosecuting attorney and each full-time assistant
15 authorized by this act. Payments under this section shall
16 be made annually on or before June 30.

18 **Section 2.** Nine hundred ninety-four thousand six
19 hundred forty-seven dollars (\$994,647.00) or as much
20 thereof as is necessary is appropriated from the general
21 fund to the county and prosecuting attorney agency for
22 purposes of this act.
