AN ACT relating to transportation; authorizing local jurisdictions to regulate motorized skateboards; providing for definitions; conforming provisions; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv)(intro), (E)(intro) and by creating a new paragraph (xxix), 31-5-102(a)(xxiii), (xxiv) and by creating a new paragraph (lxii) and 31-5-109(a)(xvii) are amended to read:

31-1-101. Definitions.

(a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this act:

(xv) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is self-propelled except vehicles moved solely by human power <u>or motorized skateboards</u>. The term includes the following vehicles as hereafter defined:

"Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle (E) having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three (3) wheels in contact with the ground but which may have attached thereto а sidecar for the purpose of transporting a single For the purpose of registration and titling passenger. "motorcycle" includes motorized bicycles and scooters, but and off-road excludes mopeds, motorized skateboards recreational vehicles as defined in subparagraph (K) of this paragraph. A recreational vehicle primarily designed for off-road use which is fifty (50) inches or less in width, has an unladen weight of nine hundred (900) pounds or less, has four (4) low pressure tires as defined by ORIGINAL SENATE FILE NO. 0093

subparagraph (K) of this paragraph, is designed to be ridden astride a seat or saddle, and is not a golf cart may be registered and titled under this act and is deemed to be:

(xxix) "Motorized skateboard" means a selfpropelled device which has a motor or engine, a deck on which a person may ride and at least two (2) wheels in contact with the ground and which is not otherwise defined in this act as a "motor vehicle", "motorcycle", "motordriven cycle" or "pedestrian vehicle".

31-5-102. Definitions.

(a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this act:

(xxiii) "Motor-driven cycle" means any motorcycle, including motor scooters and motorized bicycles having an engine with less than one hundred fifty (150) cubic centimeters displacement or with five (5) brake horsepower or less <u>but does not include motorized</u> skateboards;

(xxiv) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is self-propelled except vehicles moved solely by human power, motorized skateboards and golf carts as defined by paragraph (a)(lxi) of this section;

(lxii) "Motorized skateboard" means a selfpropelled device which has a motor or engine, a deck on which a person may ride and at least two (2) wheels in contact with the ground and which is not otherwise defined in this act as a "motor vehicle", "motorcycle", "motordriven cycle" or "pedestrian vehicle". 31-5-109. General powers of local authorities.

(a) This act does not prevent local authorities with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of the police power from:

(xvii) Regulating persons upon skates, coasters, sleds, motorized skateboards and other toy vehicles;

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
