Election code revisions-2.

Sponsored by: Joint Corporations, Elections and Political
Subdivisions Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; authorizing political parties
2 to set their own convention and meeting dates; prohibiting
3 unsuccessful candidates at a primary election from seeking
4 the same office at the ensuing general election in any
5 manner; requiring specified election forms to contain the
6 address of the candidate; making conforming amendments; and
7 providing for an effective date.

9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-2-110(a), 22-4-105, 22-4-106,
12 22-4-110, 22-4-111, 22-4-115, 22-5-204(b), 22-5-205(a),
13 22-5-301, 22-5-302, 22-22-202(a) and 22-29-110(b) are
14 amended to read:

16 **22-2-110. Computing periods of time.**

1

2 (a) Periods of time are computed by excluding the
3 specific day and counting the prescribed number of days,
4 including Saturdays, Sundays and full legal holidays.
5 ~~Except as provided by W.S. 22-4-115,~~ If the first day of a
6 time period falls on a Saturday, Sunday or full legal
7 holiday, the preceding day which is not a Saturday, Sunday
8 or full legal holiday shall be used. If the last day of a
9 time period falls on a Saturday, Sunday or full legal
10 holiday, the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or
11 full legal holiday shall be used.

12

13 **22-4-105. County central committee odd year meeting;**
14 **notice; election of chairman, state committeeman and**
15 **committeewoman.**

16

17 The county central committee shall meet at the county seat
18 ~~during the month of March of~~ each odd-numbered year at a
19 time and place determined by the county chairman. The
20 county chairman shall publish notice of the meeting in a
21 newspaper of general circulation within the county not less
22 than ten (10) days before this meeting. At the meeting, the
23 county central committee shall elect the chairman of the
24 county central committee, one (1) state committeeman and

1 one (1) state committeewoman and other offices as provided
2 by the party bylaws. A state political party may provide in
3 its rules for the election of additional state committeemen
4 and additional state committeewomen. Neither the chairman,
5 state committeeman or state committeewoman need be members
6 of the county central committee.

7

8 **22-4-106. County convention.**

9

10 The county convention of each political party shall meet ~~on~~
11 ~~the first Friday after the first Tuesday of March~~ in
12 even-numbered years.

13

14 **22-4-110. Composition of state central committee.**

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16 The state central committee consists of state committeemen
17 and committeewomen and county chairmen elected at the ~~March~~
18 odd-numbered year meeting of the county central committees,
19 and of any other party officials provided by the bylaws of
20 the party.

21

22 **22-4-111. State central committee organizational**
23 **meeting; notice.**

24

1 The state central committee shall hold an organizational
2 meeting ~~during the last fifteen (15) days in April of~~ in
3 odd-numbered years, at which it shall elect from electors
4 registered in the party a chairman, secretary and other
5 officers as provided in the rules of the party. The state
6 chairman shall mail notice of the time and place of this
7 meeting to each member of the committee not later than ten
8 (10) days before the meeting.

9

10 **22-4-115. Date of party state convention.**

11

12 Each political party shall hold a state convention ~~on one~~
13 ~~(1) of the first three (3) Saturdays in May of~~ in
14 even-numbered years.

15

16 **22-5-204. Application for nomination or election;**
17 **party registration; form.**

18

19 (b) An eligible person seeking nomination or election
20 for a partisan office shall be registered in the party
21 whose nomination he seeks and shall file an application in
22 substantially the following form:

1 **22-5-302. Unsuccessful primary candidates precluded.**

2

3 An unsuccessful candidate for office at a primary election
4 may not seek nomination by petition, nor as a write-in
5 candidate, for the same office ~~filled~~ at the next general
6 election.

7

8 **22-22-202. Filing of application; form.**

9

10 (a) A qualified elector may be nominated for the
11 office of school district trustee or member of a community
12 college board by filing an application for election in the
13 office of the county clerk not more than ninety (90) nor
14 less than seventy (70) days prior to the election. The
15 application shall be in substantially the following form:

18 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRUSTEE

20 I, the undersigned, swear or affirm that I was born on
21,(year), and that I have been a resident of the
22 State of Wyoming since, and that I am a registered

24 district (and resident of trustee residence area or

13 **22-29-110. County clerk to publish proclamation;**
 14 **filing period.**

16 (b) Not more than thirty-nine (39) and not less than
 17 thirty (30) days before the formation election, candidates
 18 may file an application for election in the office of the
 19 county clerk. The principal act shall determine who is
 20 eligible to be a candidate. The application shall be in
 21 substantially the following form:
