1 shall be paid in equal monthly installments on the last 2 working day of the month: 3 4 (i) Supreme court justices shall receive an 5 annual salary of ninety-three thousand dollars (\$93,000.00) one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000.00); 6 7 8 9-1-802. Election; term; qualifications; full-time; 9 private practice prohibited; exception; salary; vacancies. 10 11 (d) Each district attorney shall receive an annual 12 salary in an amount equal to seventy-five percent (75%) 13 ninety percent (90%) of the annual salary provided for 14 supreme court justices. 15 16 Section 2. 17 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to 18 supreme court two million two hundred sixty-two 19 the 20 thousand five hundred sixty-two dollars (\$2,262,562.00) for
