2002 SPECIAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to the division of criminal investigation; requiring the division of criminal investigation to investigate suspected violations involving computer crimes and crimes involving sexual exploitation of children; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 9-1-618(b) by creating new paragraphs (iv) and (v) is amended to read:

9-1-618. Agents to be safeguarded as peace officers; general assistance to state, county or local authorities; investigative duties.

(b) The division shall investigate:

(iv) Suspected violations of computer crimes as specified in W.S. 6-3-501 through 6-3-505;

(v) Suspected violations involving the sexual exploitation of children as specified in W.S. 6-4-303.
