2002 SPECIAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to the state mining council; requiring the state mining council to promulgate rules limiting the time within which a complaint shall be filed as specified; and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 30-2-311(a) is amended to read:

**30-2-311. Revocation of certificate after notice and hearing; reexamination; revocation of certificate of inspector or deputy; filing of certificate.**

(a) Any certificate issued by the council or temporary permit issued by the inspector may be revoked by the council after hearing under W.S. 16-3-101 through 16-3-115 for violation of this act or rules and regulations promulgated under this act, intoxication while in duty status, mental disabilities or neglect of duty. The council shall establish by rule a time limit after the alleged date of an incident as provided in this subsection within which a complaint shall be filed. No person whose certificate has been revoked under this section for less than ninety (90) days shall be examined by the council. No person whose certificate has been revoked under this section shall be reissued a certificate unless the council finds the incapacity, if any, on which the revocation was based has ceased to exist.
