FIFTY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING  
2002 SPECIAL SESSION

A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of a state highway as the "Sacagawea Trail."

WHEREAS the Wyoming state legislature desires to support relations with the Shoshone Indian Tribe and tourism; and

WHEREAS the designation of a portion of a highway in the state as the "Sacagawea Trail" would accomplish both purposes.

*Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Members of the Legislature Of The State Of Wyoming, a majority of all the members of each houses, voting separately, concurring therein:*

**Section 1.** That highway 287 from West Yellowstone to Fort Washakie is designated as the "Sacagawea Trail."
