AN ACT relating to a statewide education data system; 1 establishing a design team to assist 2 the state superintendent of public instruction in the development of 3 4 a statewide data system; specifying design team membership; prescribing criteria for data system development; imposing 5 and reporting requirements; providing 6 duties an 7 appropriation; and providing for an effective date. 8

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 10

(a) A design team is established to assist the state
superintendent of public instruction in the investigation,
development and implementation of a statewide education

data system specified under subsection (b) of this section. 1 2 The design team shall be comprised of the following: 3 4 (i) Two (2) members appointed by the state 5 superintendent of public instruction, with expertise in education data technology and data systems; 6 7 (ii) Two (2) members who are employed by Wyoming 8 9 school districts as technology directors and are appointed by the state superintendent of public instruction with the 10 11 advise of district directors of technology; 12 Wyoming school 13 (iii) One (1) district superintendent selected by the Wyoming association of 14 school administrators; 15 16 (iv) 17 One (1) member of the Wyoming senate appointed by the president of the senate; 18 19 20 (1) member of the Wyoming house (v) One of 21 representative appointed by the speaker of the house. 22 The statewide education data system shall provide 23 (b) 24 a statewide capability to share and access educational 2

1 information between school districts and the state, through 2 common labeling and storage of data, both internally for 3 school district use and externally for state and federal 4 data collections. To the extent possible, the data system 5 shall use existing data bases of districts and the state, and focus on acquiring the necessary system components to 6 7 uniform, statewide reporting of enable educational information. 8

10 (c) The state superintendent shall in consultation with the design team established under subsection (a) of 11 this section, develop and issue a request for proposal 12 (RFP) in conformance with this section which at minimum 13 shall include: 14

(i) Requirements for universal school district 16 17 participation in the statewide education data system following complete analysis and review of data systems 18 existing within districts and necessary modifications to 19 20 achieve district compliancy;

22 (ii) Infrastructure necessary to support the statewide education data system; 23

1 (iii) Training requirements for district 2 participation; 3 4 (iv) A thorough review of system feasibility 5 including the use of test surveys and pilot projects. 6 design team shall advise 7 (d) The the state superintendent in developing the RFP required under this 8 9 section and assist the state superintendent in reviewing and evaluating all proposals submitted in response to the 10 RFP. Following review and evaluation, the state 11 12 superintendent shall, if a proposal is accepted and meets the requirements of this section, enter into contract to 13 implement the proposal subject to available funds 14 appropriated under section 2 of this act. 15 16

(e) On or before December 31, 2003, and on behalf of the design team, the state superintendent shall report to the joint education interim committee on a proposed statewide data system developed pursuant to this section. Recommendations shall be structured to enable implementation during the 2005-2006 school year, and shall include necessary enabling legislation.

Section 2. Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) 1 2 is appropriated from the general fund to the state superintendent of public instruction for purposes of this 3 4 act, to be expended by the department for the expenses of 5 the design team, staff support and consulting expertise.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 8 Wyoming 9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Constitution. 10
