1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming

2 Constitution to modify the prohibition against the

3 legislature limiting the amount of damages that may be

4 recovered for causing personal injury or death of any

5 person.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,

8 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting

9 separately, concurring therein:

11 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming

12 Constitution, Article 10, Section 4 is proposed for

13 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the

14 next general election for approval or rejection to become

1 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a

2 majority of the electors at the election:

4 Article 10, Section 4. Damages for personal injuries
5 or death; worker's compensation.

6

7 No law shall be enacted limiting the amount of actual 8 economic damages to be recovered for causing the injury or 9 death of any person. The legislature may enact laws to 10 limit the amount of noneconomic damages to be recovered for 11 causing the injury or death of any person. Any contract or 12 agreement with any employee waiving any right to recover 13 damages for causing the death or injury of any employee 14 shall be void. As to all extrahazardous employments the legislature shall provide by law for the accumulation and 15 maintenance of a fund or funds out of which shall be paid 16 compensation as may be fixed by law according to proper 17 18 classifications to each person injured in such employment or to the dependent families of such as die as the result 19 of such injuries, except in case of injuries due solely to 20 21 the culpable negligence of the injured employee. 22 or funds shall be accumulated, paid into the state treasury 23 and maintained in such manner as may be provided by law. 24 Monies in the fund shall be expended only for compensation

authorized by this section, for administration and 1 2 management of the Workers' Compensation Act, debt service 3 related to the fund and for workplace safety programs conducted by the state as authorized by law. The right of 4 each employee to compensation from the fund shall be in 5 6 lieu of and shall take the place of any and all rights of 7 action against any employer contributing as required by law 8 to the fund in favor of any person or persons by reason of 9 the injuries or death. Subject to conditions specified by 10

law, the legislature may allow employments not designated

extrahazardous to be covered by the state fund at the 11

option of the employer. To the extent an employer elects 12

13 to be covered by the state fund and contributes to the fund

14 as required by law, the employer shall enjoy the same

immunity as provided for extrahazardous employments. 15

Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse 17 the following statement on the proposed amendment: 18

This amendment would allow the Wyoming legislature to 20 enact laws to limit the amount of noneconomic damages that 21 22 may be recovered for injury or death of any person.
