A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; repealing
2 certain benchmarks and requirements for the Wyoming
3 business council annual report; repealing film and video
4 promotion provisions; making conforming amendments; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-12-102(a)(viii) is amended to read:

11 **9-12-102. Definitions.**

13 (a) As used in this act, the following terms have the
14 following meanings, except where the context clearly
15 indicates otherwise:

1 (viii) "This act" means W.S. 9-12-101 through
2 ~~9-12-401~~ 9-12-307.

4 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-12-107(b), 9-12-112(a)(iii),
5 9-12-401 and 1998 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 6, Section
6 1 (d)(ii)(C), (F), (iii)(A) and (B)(II) through (V) are
7 repealed.

9 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.

13 **Staff comments:** The Wyoming business council is directed
14 to measure the effectiveness of the economic development
15 act in its annual report by using certain non-codified
16 benchmarks. This draft repeals the following benchmarks as
17 requested by the business council at the July Minerals
18 meeting: Sector growth/decline in primary industries;
19 fiscal stability and balanced revenue; workforce skills and
20 education; primary school enrollment; infant mortality
21 rate; crime rate and air quality.

23 This draft also repeals the sales/use tax rebate program
24 for the motion picture industry (ineffective since 6/30/99
25 sunset). The draft repeals those provisions that require
26 that the business council review, approve and annually
27 report the rebates. The draft conforms the statutory
28 citation of the act.
