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7	<b>Section 1.</b> W.S. 39-14-303(b)(ii) is amended to read:

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11	(b) Basis of tax (valuation). The following shall
12	apply:
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14	(ii) The department shall calculate the value of
15	trona ore for severance and ad valorem tax purposes by

using the individual producer's fair market value of soda 1 2 ash f.o.b. plant multiplied by the industry factor divided 3 by the individual producer's trona to soda ash ratio less 4 exempt royalties. The industry factor shall be calculated 5 by the department using a combination of the reported production for the two (2) previous calendar years by 6 7 dividing the composite trona value per ton of soda ash by the composite soda ash sales price. The minerals division 8 9 of the department of audit shall conduct an audit of the 10 trona industry not later than December 31, 1990. The 11 information shall be provided to the department of revenue 12 to establish the industry factor. The factor will be 13 recomputed at two (2) year intervals and will be based on 14 an average of the data for the two (2) prior years. The new 15 factor will be applied prospectively thirty-two and five-16 tenths percent (32.5%); 17 18 Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2004.
