A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; modifying qualifications  
2 and fees for specified hunting licenses; and providing for  
3 effective dates.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(e) is amended to read:

8  
9 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**  
10 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**  
11 **gratuitous licenses.**

13 (e) The department shall issue for a fee ~~of two~~  
14 ~~dollars (\$2.00)~~ established by rule of the commission a  
15 resident deer, ~~or~~ antelope or elk license ~~and for a fee of~~

1 ~~five dollars (\$5.00) an elk license~~ to any resident who ~~was~~  
2 ~~born on or before January 1, 1930~~ is at least seventy (70)  
3 years of age prior to the issuance of the license, who has  
4 continuously resided in Wyoming for at least the forty (40)  
5 years immediately preceding application for the license and  
6 who is physically able to personally hunt and pursue his  
7 own game. The fee established for a license under this  
8 subsection shall be not more than eighty percent (80%) nor  
9 less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the resident fee  
10 specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular species.

11

12 **Section 2.** The game and fish commission may adopt  
13 rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this  
14 act upon the effective date of this section.

15

16 **Section 3.** (a) Section 2 of this act is effective  
17 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
18 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
19 the Wyoming Constitution.

21 (b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of this  
22 section, this act is effective January 1, 2004.
