W.S. 23-1-705(e) is amended to read: 7 8 23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope 9 hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses; 10 11 gratuitous licenses. 12 13 (e) The department shall issue for a fee of two 14 dollars (\$2.00) established by rule of the commission a resident deer, or antelope or elk license and for a fee of 15

five dollars (\$5.00) an elk license to any resident who was 1 2 born on or before January 1, 1930 is at least seventy (70) 3 years of age prior to the issuance of the license, who has 4 continuously resided in Wyoming for at least the forty (40) 5 years immediately preceding application for the license and who is physically able to personally hunt and pursue his 6 7 own game. The fee established for a license under this subsection shall be not more than eighty percent (80%) nor 8 less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the resident fee 9 10 specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular species.

12 Section 2. The game and fish commission may adopt 13 rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this 14 act upon the effective date of this section.

16 Section 3. (a) Section 2 of this act is effective 17 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a 18 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of 19 the Wyoming Constitution.

(b) Except as provided in subsection (a) of thissection, this act is effective January 1, 2004.
