6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7

8 Section 1. W.S. 23-2-101(e) and (j), 23-2-107(e), 9 23-2-201(d) and 23-3-105(b) are amended to read: 10

11 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application 12 fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency 13 required. 14

(e) Resident and nonresident license applicants shall pay an application fee in an amount specified by this subsection upon submission of an application for purchase

1 of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license or wild bison license. The resident application fee shall 2 be three dollars (\$3.00) and the nonresident application 3 fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) fifteen dollars (\$15.00). 4 5 The application fee is in addition to the fees prescribed by subsections (f) and (j) of this section and by W.S. 6 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the department either 7 directly or through an authorized selling agent of the 8 9 department. At the beginning of each month, the commission shall set aside all of the fees collected during calendar 10 year 1980 and not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of 11 the fees collected thereafter pursuant to this subsection 12 13 to establish and maintain a working balance of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), to compensate owners or 14 15 lessees of property damaged by game animals and game birds. 16

17 (j) Subject to W.S. 23-2-101(f), the following hunting licenses and tags may be purchased for the fee 18 19 indicated and subject to the limitations provided:

1 (b) The landowner's coupon shall promptly be 2 detached, dated, signed and delivered to the landowner. The 3 landowner on or before February 1 following the year for 4 which the license was valid, shall deliver to the 5 department the coupon and an affidavit that the antelope, deer or elk for which the coupon was delivered was killed 6 on his land. Upon receipt of the coupon and affidavit the 7 department shall pay the landowner eleven dollars (\$11.00) 8 9 thirteen dollars (\$13.00) for each coupon from an antelope, 10 deer or elk license. Landowner's coupons are not transferable. Any unauthorized person attempting to collect 11 any sum for any landowner's coupon is guilty of a second 12 13 degree misdemeanor. Effective January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2004, the department shall provide a checkoff 14 box on each landowner coupon affidavit claim form that 15 16 offers the claimant the opportunity to designate the animal 17 damage management board to receive his payment amount for landowner coupons claimed on that form. For each claim made 18 where the landowner has designated their payment to the 19 20 damage management board, the department animal shall 21 transfer that amount to the animal damage management 22 account created by W.S. 11-6-306 and the department shall retain such fees related to those administrative costs of 23 24 the transfer.
