Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 23-1-701(b) and (c) is amended to

23-1-701. Selling agents; administration of oaths;

14 game tags.

(b) Each selling agent shall retain fifty cents 1 2 (\$.50) for each license and twenty-five cents (\$.25) for 3 each conservation stamp under W.S. 23-2-306 he sells may 4 charge an additional fee for each license, permit, stamp or 5 tag he sells or distributes pursuant to this act. failure to comply with this section, Selling agents shall 6 7 not be entitled to fifty cents (\$.50) may charge a fee not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) per license or tag and twenty-8 9 five cents (\$.25) fifty cents (\$.50) for each conservation 10 permit or stamp sold. and shall be liable on their bond. 11 The fee shall be in addition to the price established for 12 the license, permit, stamp or tag by this act. No employee 13 of the commission shall receive any commission on nor 14 charge any additional fee for licenses, permits, stamps or tags sold or distributed pursuant to this act. 15

On or before the 10th of each month every selling agent shall file a report for the preceding month with the commission on forms approved by the commission. Selling agents shall also remit all money collected during the previous month, less commission excluding any additional fees charged pursuant to subsection (b) of this section, and shall account for and deliver all surplus, unused and

damaged licenses, permits, stamps, tags, and stubs of 1

2 licenses received by the selling agent to the commission.
