for

1 AN ACT relating to food and drugs; providing for a license
2 fee waiver for nonprofit organizations serving free meals;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-124(b) is amended to read:

9 **35-7-124. License required; exemptions.**

11 (b) Written application for a new license shall be
12 made on a form approved by the department of agriculture
13 and provided by the department of agriculture or the local
14 health department and shall be signed by the applicant. An
15 initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall
16 accompany each application. The license fee for a temporary

1 food event shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) which
2 event shall not exceed fourteen (14) days. License
3 requirements and fees for temporary food events operated by
4 nonprofit organizations shall be waived. The fees required
5 by this subsection shall be waived for nonprofit
6 organizations that provide all meals to persons for free.
7 Licenses shall expire one (1) year after the date of
8 issuance unless suspended or revoked. Licenses may be
9 renewed each year upon application to the department or
10 local health department accompanied by a fee of fifty
11 dollars (\$50.00). Any establishment which has a license on
12 the effective date of this section shall pay a fee of fifty
13 dollars (\$50.00) for the following year and shall not be
14 liable to pay the initial license fee of one hundred
15 dollars (\$100.00).

17 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
