A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; amending specifications
2 for license plates; and providing for an effective date.

4 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-204(b) is amended to read:

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8 **31-2-204. Issuance of certificates of registration**
9 **and license plates by county; form.**

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11 (b) Except as otherwise provided, license plates
12 shall be of metal not less than twelve (12) inches long in
13 the left-hand end of which shall be embossed arabic
14 numerals for the county in which issued, followed by the
15 embossed bucking horse and rider emblem and a distinctive
16 number assigned to the vehicle, set forth in embossed
17 numerals and letters as determined by the department and

1 above or underneath such numerals shall be the embossed
2 word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the year of issue or
3 validation. License plates issued to dealers and for
4 trailers shall contain appropriate identification which may
5 be in lieu of the bucking horse and rider emblem. License
6 plates shall be changed or validated annually. There shall
7 be a marked contrast between the color of the plate and
8 that of the numerals and letters and the background of all
9 plates shall be fully reflectorized. Motorcycle plates
10 shall not be less than three (3) inches wide and six (6)
11 inches long. Antique license plates shall bear no date and
12 shall bear the inscription "Pioneer Wyo". License stickers
13 for trucks and trailers used by any farmer or rancher for
14 the transportation of livestock, feed or unprocessed
15 agricultural products owned and produced by the farmer or
16 rancher from the place of production to market and of ranch
17 supplies intended solely for the use of the farmer or
18 rancher, and not for sale, on the return trip, and not for
19 the transportation of goods and persons for hire shall bear
20 the inscription "Farm". Upon application to the department
21 and payment of a fee as provided by W.S. 31-3-102(a)(xix),
22 veteran license stickers bearing the inscription "Veteran"
23 and designating the conflict service of the veteran may be
24 issued to the veterans' affairs commission in a format

1 approved by the department. The veterans' affairs
2 commission may sell the veteran license sticker to
3 qualified veterans at a fee not to exceed cost, plus ten
4 dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle. Any fees collected by the
5 veterans' affairs commission under this subsection shall be
6 deposited in the veterans' affairs commission expendable
7 trust fund. The veterans' affairs commission shall
8 establish eligibility criteria for veterans applying for a
9 veteran license sticker. A qualified veteran purchasing a
10 veteran license sticker manufactured by the department and
11 sold by the veterans' affairs commission may display the
12 sticker on the license plate issued by the county
13 treasurer. The provisions of W.S. 31-2-205(a)(iv) shall not
14 apply to any veteran license sticker manufactured by the
15 department and displayed as provided in this section.

17 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
