1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; prohibiting certain
2 acts relating to liquefied petroleum gas containers;
3 providing a penalty; and providing for an effective date.

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-9-401 is created to read:

LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS CONTAINERS

12 **6-9-401. Liquefied petroleum gas containers; unlawful**
13 **acts; penalty.**

15 (a) Unless a liquefied petroleum gas container is
16 owned by the person or its use, or the action, is

1 authorized by the owner of the container, a person shall
2 not:

3

4 (i) Sell, barter or exchange, install, fill,
5 refill, deliver or permit to be delivered or used in any
6 manner the liquefied petroleum gas container;

7

8 (ii) Dismantle, evacuate, service or tamper with
9 the liquefied petroleum gas container; or

11 (iii) Deface, erase, obliterate, cover up,
12 remove, conceal or change the name or other identification
13 of the owner or the information on the manufacturer's
14 specification plate or place the name of a person other
15 than the owner on the liquefied petroleum gas container.

16

17 (b) A person who violates this section commits a
18 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than
19 six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty
20 dollars (\$750.00), or both.

22 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
