A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to legislative expenses; increasing the
2 amount to be received by legislators for expenses; making
3 appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-5-101(b) is amended to read:

8

9 **28-5-101. Schedule of compensation, per diem and**
10 **travel expenses.**

12 (b) The amount to be received by each member of the
13 legislature for expenses is increased to forty-four dollars
14 (\$44.00) per day effective January 1, 1980, to sixty
15 dollars (\$60.00) per day effective January 1, 1983, ~~and~~ to
16 eighty dollars (\$80.00) per day effective January 9, 1995

1 and to ninety dollars (\$90.00) per day effective January 1,
2 2002.

4 **Section 2.** Appropriations.

5
6 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to
7 the Legislative Service Office the sum of forty-two
8 thousand dollars (\$42,000.00) or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary to pay the cost of increased legislative expenses
10 for January 1, 2002 through June 30, 2002.

11
12 (b) Further, there is appropriated from the general
13 fund to the Legislative Service Office the sum of one
14 hundred twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$127,000.00) or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary to pay the cost of
16 increased legislative expenses for the fiscal biennium
17 beginning July 1, 2002.

19 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
20 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
21 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
22 Constitution.
