A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to driver's licenses; modifying
2 application requirements for licenses and permits;
3 specifying information to be included on licenses;
4 repealing prohibition on issuing driver's license to a
5 person who is in violation of immigration laws; and
6 providing for an effective date.

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-111(b)(iv) and
11 31-7-115(a)(iii)(C) are amended to read:

13 **31-7-111. Application for license or permit**
14 **generally.**

(iv) The person's social security number, temporary identification number issued by the Internal Revenue Service for a person who does not qualify for a social security number or other numbers or letters deemed appropriate on applications for instruction permits, driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses and commercial driver instruction permits;

(a) Upon the satisfactory completion of any required examination, the division shall issue to every qualifying applicant a driver's license, and:

(iii) The driver's license shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:

(C) The full legal name, any identifying numbers or letters deemed appropriate, date of birth, mailing address, height, weight and sex of the licensee. Unless otherwise required by federal law, the social security number or temporary identification number issued by the Internal Revenue Service, of the person shall not be

1 required on a driver's license. The division shall provide
2 on the application form required by W.S. 31-7-111(a) an
3 option for the applicant to include his social security
4 number or temporary identification number on his driver's
5 license;

7 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-7-108(b)(vi) is repealed.

9 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
