Student nutrition-beverages.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; regulating beverages offered
2 to students in schools; providing enforcement; and
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-4-601 is created to read:

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ARTICLE 6

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STUDENT HEALTH

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12 **21-4-601. Student nutrition; beverages.**

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14 (a) The only beverages that shall be offered for sale
15 to elementary, middle school and high school students are
16 as follows:

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1 (i) Water;

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3 (ii) Milk, including chocolate milk, soy milk,
4 rice milk and other similar dairy or nondairy milk; and

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6 (iii) One hundred percent (100%) fruit juices,
7 or fruit-based drinks that are composed of no less than
8 fifty percent (50%) fruit juice and that have no added
9 sweeteners.

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11 (b) The restriction on beverages offered for sale to
12 students applies from one-half (1/2) hour before the start
13 of the school day until one-half (1/2) hour after the end
14 of the school day.

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16 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-2-202(a) by creating a new
17 paragraph (xxiii) is amended to read:

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19 **21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.**

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21 (a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
22 the state superintendent shall:

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1 (xxiii) Promote student health in school,
2 including nutritional health through department staff and
3 programs, and enforce district compliance with W.S.
4 21-4-601 regulating beverages offered to students.

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6 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2002.
