

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. HJ0012

Veteran's license plates-constitutional amendment.

A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION providing for the disposition of
2 revenues from sales of veterans' special motor vehicle
3 license plates.

5 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
6 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
7 *separately, concurring therein:*

9 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
10 Constitution, Article 15, Section 16 is proposed for
11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
12 next general election for approval or rejection to become
13 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
14 majority of the electors at the election:

16 **Article 15, Section 16. Disposition of fees, excises**
17 **and license taxes on vehicles and gasoline.**

2 No moneys derived from fees, excises, or license taxes
3 levied by the state and exclusive of fees charged for
4 special veterans' license plates authorized by law, and
5 registration fees and licenses or excise taxes imposed by a
6 county or municipality, relating to registration, operation
7 or use of vehicles on public highways, streets or alleys,
8 or to fuels used for propelling such vehicles, shall be
9 expended for other than cost of administering such laws,
10 statutory refunds and adjustments allowed therein, payment
11 of highway obligations, costs for construction,
12 reconstruction, maintenance and repair of public highways,
13 county roads, bridges, and streets, alleys and bridges in
14 cities and towns, and expense of enforcing state traffic
15 laws.

16

17 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
18 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

19

1 The adoption of this amendment would provide that fees from
2 the sale of special veterans' motor vehicle license plates
3 would not have to be expended to pay the costs of highway
4 obligations, construction, reconstruction or maintenance of
5 public highways or for the administration and enforcement
6 of state traffic laws.
