Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 35-7-124(b) is amended to read:

## 35-7-124. License required; exemptions.

(b) Written application for a new license shall be made on a form approved by the department of agriculture and provided by the department of agriculture or the local health department and shall be signed by the applicant. An initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall accompany each application. The license fee for a temporary

1 food event shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) which 2 event shall not exceed fourteen (14) days. License

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
