1 authorized by the owner of the container, a person shall 2 not: 3 4 (i) Sell, barter or exchange, install, fill, 5 refill, deliver or permit to be delivered or used in any 6 manner the liquefied petroleum gas container; 7 (ii) Dismantle, evacuate, service or tamper with 8 9 the liquefied petroleum gas container; or 10 11 (iii) Deface, erase, obliterate, cover up, remove, conceal or change the name or other identification 12 13 of the owner or the information on the manufacturer's 14 specification plate or place the name of a person other than the owner on the liquefied petroleum gas container. 15 16 17 (b) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 18 six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty 19 20 dollars (\$750.00), or both. 21 22 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002. 23
