1 AN ACT relating to state legislative districts; providing 2 definitions; providing a plan for state legislative

3 districts based upon the 2000 census; providing for

4 eligibility of a candidate for the state legislature;

5 providing a repealer; providing an appropriation; and

6 providing for an effective date.

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-2-116 through 28-2-119 are 11 repealed and recreated as W.S. 28-2-116 through 28-2-119 to

2 definitions. 3 4 (a) As used in W.S. 28-2-116 through 28-2-119: 5 (i) "Census block" means a geographic area of 6 7 the state of Wyoming specified by the United States bureau of the census in accordance with the 2000 decennial census 8 9 and identified uniquely by census block number; 10 (ii) "Voter tabulation district" or "VTD" means 11 12 a geographic area of the state of Wyoming specified by the United States bureau of the census in accordance with the 13 14 2000 decennial census and identified by Wyoming VTD name 15 and number; 16 17 (iii) "This act" means W.S. 28-2-116 through 18 28-2-119. 19 20 (b) As used in W.S. 28-2-118 and 28-2-119 unless the 21 context otherwise requires: 22 (i) "District (number)" designates 23 24 legislative district number assigned to a house or senate 1 legislative district from which a legislator is elected

2 under this act;

3

4 (ii) "(Name of) County" designates either that

5 the entire named Wyoming county is within the legislative

6 district or that a portion of the named Wyoming county as

7 specified is within the legislative district;

8

9 (iii) "VTD" designates either that the entire

10 voter tabulation district as named by the United States

11 bureau of the census for the 2000 decennial census within

12 the named county is a part of the legislative district or

13 that a portion of the named voter tabulation district

14 within the named county as specified is a part of the

15 legislative district;

16

17 (iv) "Blocks" designates the entire census block

18 as numbered by the United States bureau of the census for

19 the 2000 decennial census within the named VTD and county

20 is a part of the legislative district.

22 (c) W.S. 28-2-118 creates legislative districts for

23 the Wyoming senate and W.S. 28-2-119 creates legislative

24 districts for the Wyoming house of representatives.

(d) The secretary of state shall maintain the United States Public Law 94-171 data for the 2000 decennial census that office received from the United States bureau of the census and make it available for public inspection in a hardcopy or electronic format during regular business

19 (a) Subsection (b) of this section creates
20 legislative districts for the Wyoming senate consisting of
21 the numbered legislative districts contained therein. The
22 number of senators to be elected from each legislative
23 district shall be as specified in subsection (b) of this
24 section. The area within a county, voter tabulation

- 1 district or census block as provided in paragraphs (i)
- 2 through (iii) of this subsection is determined using the
- 3 United States bureau of census topologically integrated
- 4 geographic encoding and referencing data base (TIGER®).
- 5 Each numbered legislative district in subsection (b) of
- 6 this section consists of the combined geographic area
- 7 within the:

8

- 9 (i) Entire specified county, if the county alone
- 10 is listed with no geographic subdivision listed below it;

11

- 12 (ii) Voter tabulation district, if any are
- 13 listed below the particular county; and

14

- 15 (iii) Census block, if any are listed below the
- 16 particular voter tabulation district. A census block listed
- 17 below a voter tabulation district indicates a split voter
- 18 tabulation district.

- 23 census blocks for split voter tabulation districts in the

2 (a) Subsection (b) of this section creates 3 legislative districts for the Wyoming house 4 representatives consisting of the numbered legislative 5 districts contained therein. The number of representatives to be elected from each legislative district shall be as 6 specified in subsection (b) of this section. The area 7 within a county, voter tabulation district or census block 8 9 as provided in paragraphs (i) through (iii) of this 10 subsection is determined using the United States bureau of 11 census topologically integrated geographic encoding and 12 referencing data base (TIGER®). Each numbered legislative district in subsection (b) of this section consists of the 13 14 combined geographic area within the:

15

16 (i) Entire specified county, if the county alone
17 is listed with no geographic subdivision listed below it;

18

19 (ii) Voter tabulation district, if any are 20 listed below the particular county; and

21

22 (iii) Census block, if any are listed below the 23 particular voter tabulation district. A census block listed

6 Section 2. W.S. 22-5-102 is amended to read:

8 22-5-102. Eligibility to be a candidate for state

legislature; residency.

11 (a) For the purpose of meeting residency requirements 12 of the Wyoming constitution, a person shall not be a 13 candidate for the state legislature from a legislative district unless he has been a resident of that legislative 14 district for at least one (1) year next preceding his 15 16 election. In any general election year in which a plan of 17 legislative reapportionment districts is required but has not been enacted into law at least one (1) year prior to 18 the applicable filing periods, a person may be a candidate 19 20 for the state legislature from a legislative district if

he:

1 (i) Is a resident of the legislative district on

2 the date he files an application under W.S. 22-5-204 or a

3 petition under W.S. 22-5-301; and

4

5 (ii) Has been a resident of a county for at

6 least one (1) year next preceding his election in which any

7 portion of that legislative district is located.

8

9 **Section 3.** W.S. 28-2-115 is repealed.

10

11 **Section 4.** There is appropriated to the attorney

12 general from the general fund two hundred fifty thousand

13 dollars (\$250,000.00) to be used for legal and related

14 costs incurred in any litigation arising from the plan of

15 legislative districts contained in this act.

16

17 **Section 5.** This act is effective immediately upon

18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

20 Constitution.
