(k) Ιf an account owner makes a nonqualified withdrawal and no penalty amount is withheld pursuant to subsection $\frac{(q)}{(h)}$ of this section or the amount withheld was less than the amount required to be withheld under that subsection for nonqualified withdrawals, the account owner shall pay the unpaid portion of the penalty to the trust at the time the account owner files his federal income tax return for the taxable year of the withdrawal. If the account owner does not file a federal income tax return, the account owner shall pay the unpaid portion of the penalty to the trust on the federal income tax due date. In no case shall the unpaid portion of the penalty be paid after the date for filing the federal income tax return taking into account any authorized extensions.

1 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-16-815(g) and (j) is repealed.

Section 3. The state treasurer shall amend the rules 3 4 and regulations of the Wyoming family college savings 5 program to conform with this act. No state penalty shall imposed after January 1, 2002 for nonqualified 6 be 7 withdrawals under rules in effect prior to the effective date of this act and the state treasurer shall refund any 8 9 such penalties collected in that time period. Those funds 10 needed to comply with the refund provisions of this section 11 are hereby appropriated to the state treasurer from 12 penalties collected and deposited with the treasurer 13 pursuant to W.S. 21-16-815(q) prior to its repeal by this 14 act.

Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
