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8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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10	Section 1. W.S. 37-17-101 through 37-17-106 are

14	RATE REGULATION OF COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC UTILITIES
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16	37-17-101. Definitions.
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1 (a) As used in this chapter: 2 3 (i) "Cooperative electric utility" means any 4 nonprofit, member-owned cooperative organized under the 5 laws of the state of Wyoming and engaged in the business of distributing electric energy in the state of Wyoming; 6 7 (ii) "Member consumers" means cooperative 8 9 electric utility owners that use and pay retail electric rates for electricity distributed by the cooperative 10 11 electric utility. 12 13 37-17-102. Retail rate regulation; exemption. 14 (a) Any cooperative electric utility exempt from 15 public service commission retail rate regulation shall 16 17 remain subject to this chapter, all other provisions of Wyoming public utility law and the authority of the 18 19 commission. 20 21 (b) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to 22 alter the certificated service territory of a cooperative 23 electric utility.

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3 The board of directors of any cooperative (a) 4 electric utility may adopt a resolution for exemption from 5 the public service commission retail rate regulation and submit the resolution to the member consumers for a vote. 6 The notices, meetings, election and approval provisions 7 shall be pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in 8 9 the bylaws of the utility. Upon an affirmative vote of a 10 majority of the members voting on the resolution, the 11 election results shall be filed with the commission. On the 12 date of filing, the exemption shall become effective.

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14 (b) No cooperative electric utility may vote more 15 than once a year on the exemption.

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17 37-17-104. Adoption of retail rates; notice and
18 hearing; filing.

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20 A cooperative electric utility exempted under W.S. 21 37-17-103 shall give notice, including procedures for 22 member consumers to comment on proposed rates, and hearing 23 to member consumers of any proposed retail rate adjustment.

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1 The utility shall adopt all necessary retail rates and file 2 all retail rates with the public service commission. 3 37-17-105. Retail rate 4 adjustment; complaint; 5 investigation; resolution. 6 If within six (6) months of final implementation of a 7 retail rate adjustment a complaint signed by not less than 8 9 ten percent (10%) of all of the member consumers is filed with the commission, the commission shall investigate the 10 rate adjustment. The complaint shall be resolved pursuant 11 12 to commission hearing and enforcement procedures. The 13 commission is authorized to require the utility to revise 14 its rates if the commission finds, after investigation, 15 that the rates are inadequate or unremunerative, or unjust, 16 or unreasonable, or unjustly discriminatory, or unduly 17 preferential or otherwise in any respect in violation of any provision of this chapter. The existing rates of the 18 19 utility shall remain in effect while the rates are under 20 investigation. 21

22 37-17-106. Return to public service commission rate
23 regulation.

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1 (a) A cooperative electric utility shall return to 2 commission retail rate regulation upon an affirmative vote 3 of a majority of the member consumers voting on the 4 question submitted upon resolution of the board of 5 directors or upon a petition signed by at least ten percent (10%) of the member consumers requesting the return to 6 7 commission rate regulation. The election shall be conducted according to the provisions of W.S. 37-17-103(a). 8 9 10 (b) No cooperative electric utility may vote more 11 than once a year on the question of returning to commission 12 retail rate regulation. 13 14 Section 2. W.S. 37-1-101(a) (intro) is amended to read: 15 16 37-1-101. Definitions. 17 18 (a) As used in chapters 1, 2, 3, and 12 and 17 of this title: 19 20 21 Section 3. Legislative declaration. 22 The legislature hereby finds and declares that cooperative 23 electric utilities are owned by the member consumers they 24 5

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1 serve and are regulated by the member consumers themselves, 2 acting through an elected governing body. It is further 3 declared that the regulation of retail electric rates by 4 the public service commission under this title may be 5 duplicative of the self-regulation by the utilities and may be neither necessary nor cost effective. It is therefore 6 7 the purpose of this chapter to allow cooperative electric utilities to exempt themselves from regulation of retail 8 9 rates by the public service commission, subject to the 10 provisions of this chapter. It is further found that with 11 the exception of retail rate regulation, cooperative 12 electric utilities shall continue to be subject to all of 13 the other terms and conditions of title 37 of the Wyoming statutes pertaining to public utilities. 14

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16 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
