7 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-2-105(j) is amended to read:

- 9 7-2-105. Disposition and appraisal of property seized
- 10 or held; notice and order to show cause; judgment.

- 12 (j) Upon the entry of a judgment of forfeiture the
- 13 court shall determine the disposition to be made of the
- 14 property, which, except as provided herein for confiscated
- 15 firearms, may include the destruction or sale of the
- 16 property or the allocation of the property to some other
- 17 governmental function or use or otherwise, as the court may

1	determine.	Upon	the	entry	of	a	judgment	of	forfeiture	of	a

- 2 confiscated firearm, the court shall determine the
- 3 disposition to be made of the firearm which shall be
- 4 limited to the sale or allocation of the firearm to a
- 5 Wyoming law enforcement agency or the sale of the firearm
- 6 to a properly licensed firearm dealer, as the court may
- 7 determine, but shall not include the destruction of the
- 8 firearm unless the firearm is defective and poses a danger
- 9 to anyone who would attempt to use the firearm.

11 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
