1 AN ACT relating to railroads; modifying notification provisions regarding the condition and repair of fences; 2 3 allowing the department of transportation to authorize repairs pursuant to certain conditions; and providing for 4 an effective date. 5 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 37-9-312(a)(intro), (i), (ii) and by 10 creating a new subsection (c) is amended to read: 11 12 37-9-312. Immediate or urgent fence repairs. 13 14 (a) After notification to the railroad and by the 15 department of transportation by or the landowner concerning 16 any damaged fence or a fence in disrepair, the landowner

1 shall have the right to be reimbursed by the railroad for 2 the reasonable and customary costs for such repairs, 3 provided:

5 (i) The landowner <u>or the department of</u> 6 <u>transportation</u> gives the railroad specific information 7 concerning the location of the damage;

9 (ii) Following the notice by the landowner <u>or</u> 10 <u>the department of transportation</u>, the railroad fails to 11 commit that it will make the repairs within three (3) 12 business days of the initial notice by the landowner <u>or the</u> 13 <u>department of transportation</u> or fails to complete the 14 repairs within five (5) business days of the initial notice 15 by the landowner <u>or the department of transportation</u>; and 16

17 <u>(c) In extreme circumstances, the department of</u> 18 <u>transportation may authorize temporary repairs by the</u> 19 <u>landowner without complying with subsection (a) of this</u> 20 <u>section. The landowner shall have the right to be</u> 21 <u>reimbursed by the railroad for the reasonable and customary</u> 22 <u>costs for the temporary repairs.</u>
