a provisional license to any applicant who files an 1 application upon a form and in the manner prescribed by the 2 3 board, accompanied by the appropriate fee and who furnishes 4 satisfactory evidence to the board of the following: 5 (i) The applicant has satisfied all requirements 6 7 the educational requirement for licensure other than the requirements for examination and completion of the required 8 hours of supervised clinical experience under this act, or 9 10 the applicant has a master's or doctorate degree that is 11 clinical in content from a regionally accredited 12 institution of higher education in one (1) of the 13 disciplines identified or the applicant has a license in 14 good standing in the identified discipline from another 15 jurisdiction whose qualifications may not be substantially comparable to those required by this board; 16 17

(iv) Unless extended, <u>The provisional license</u>
shall expire be issued for a period not longer than thirtysix (36) months, after issuance or upon receipt as
determined by the board. of the applicant's passing
examination results, and completion of the required hours
of supervision whichever occurs first <u>It shall expire on</u>
the stated date or upon issuance of a license under

1	subsection (a) of this section to the provisional licensee,
2	whichever occurs first;
