- 11 convicted of felony offenses; penalties.

- 13 Any person who has previously pleaded guilty to or been
- 14 convicted of committing or attempting to commit a violent
- 15 felony or a felony under W.S. 6-5-204 (b), and has not been
- 16 pardoned and who uses or knowingly possesses any firearm is
- 17 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more

1

1 than three (3) years, a fine of not more than five thousand

2 dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

4 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
