The department reorganization plan, as approved, 2 shall be submitted to the joint labor, health and social 3 services interim committee of the legislature no later than 4 October 15, 2001 and made available to the public. The 5 committee shall hold at least one (1) public hearing regarding the plan before the 2002 budget session of the 6 7 legislature convenes. The joint labor, health and social services interim committee shall report to the legislature 8 9 by December 1, 2001, its recommendations on the plan, 10 including necessary legislation with respect to the plan. 11 The director shall review and update the department 12 reorganization plan and submit the revised plan to the 13 joint labor, health and social services interim committee 14 no later than October 15, 2002. The revised plan, as approved by act of the legislature, shall be implemented 15 16 not later than July 1, 2002-2003.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the general fund to the department of workforce services one hundred thirtysix thousand five hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$136,539.00) for the fiscal year July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003.
