| 13 | return prisoners from outside the state. Prisoners or |
| 14 | inmates of out-of-state , nonfederal or federal |
| 15 | jurisdictions shall not be incarcerated in any facility |
| 16 | operated by a local government entity private correctional |
| 17 | facility under this article. without the consent of the |

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majority of the five (5) elected officials of this state. 1 At no time shall the number of prisoners from out-of-state, 2 3 nonfederal jurisdictions incarcerated in a facility 4 operated by a local government entity under this article 5 exceed thirty percent (30%) of the capacity of that facility. Any out-of-state, nonfederal prisoner shall be 6 7 returned to the jurisdiction of origin to be released from custody by them, outside the state of Wyoming at the 8 9 appropriate time. 10 7-22-105. Standards of operation. 11 12 13 (a) All facilities governed by this article shall be designed, constructed and at all times maintained and 14 operated in accordance with the American correctional 15 association standards in force at the time of contracting. 16 17 The facility shall meet the percentage one hundred percent (100%) of standards required for accreditation every 18 standard specified by the American correctional 19 20 association., except where the contract requires compliance 21 with a higher percentage of nonmandatory standards. The 22 contract may allow the contractor an extension of time in which to meet a lower percentage of nonmandatory standards 23 24 only when the contract is for the renovation of an existing

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| 2 | longer than three (3) months to meet those standards that |
| 3 | are applicable to the physical plant. |
