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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-2-912 is created to read:

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- 15 (a) No person shall accept employment by a nursing
- 16 care facility or a home health care agency where that

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employment may involve direct patient care, unless the 1 2 person provides the facility or agency: 3 4 (i) A copy of the person's fingerprints; 5 (ii) A statement signed by the person 6 7 authorizing: 8 9 (A) The facility or agency to request a criminal history record information check; and 10 11 12 (B) An exchange of the information among 13 the nursing care facility or home health care agency, the department and the Wyoming division of criminal 14 investigation; and 15 16 17 (iii) Any other information necessary to conduct the check. 18 19 20 The provisions of subsection (a) of this section 21 shall apply to all employees of nursing care facilities or 22 home health care agencies employed on or after July 1,

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2002, for whom a criminal history record information check

has not been conducted within the previous twelve (12)

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1 months by the Wyoming board of nursing, the department of

2 health or the department of family services.

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4 (c) The nursing care facility or home health care

5 agency shall forward the information received under

6 subsection (a) or (b) of this section to the department

7 along with the fees required under W.S. 7-19-108, including

8 the fee for national criminal history record information,

9 in accordance with federal P.L. 105-277. The department

10 shall submit the request for the criminal history record

11 information check to the division of criminal

12 investigation.

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14 (d) Upon receipt of the criminal history record

15 information, the department shall advise the nursing care

16 facility or the home health care agency of the results of

17 the criminal history record information check.
