## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; creating the crimes 2 of the manufacture, possession, sale, delivery, use or
- 3 attempted or threatened use of a weapon of destruction or
- 4 hoax weapon of destruction; providing elements of the
- 5 crimes; providing penalties; providing definitions;
- 6 providing an exemption; and providing for an effective
- 7 date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-507 is created to read:

12

- 13 6-2-507. Weapons of destruction; manufacture,
- 14 possession, sale, delivery, display, use or attempted or
- 15 threatened use of a weapon of destruction or hoax weapon of
- destruction prohibited; definitions; penalties.

2 person who, without lawful authority, (a) A 3 manufactures, possesses, sells, delivers, displays, uses, 4 threatens to use, attempts to use or conspires to use or 5 who makes readily accessible to others a weapon of destruction, including any biological agent, toxin, vector 6 7 or delivery system as those terms are defined in this section, is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment 8 9 for not more than twenty (20) years and if death results, shall be punished by death, life imprisonment or life 10

imprisonment without parole, according to law.

13 Any person who, without lawful authority, 14 manufactures, possesses, sells, delivers, displays, uses, threatens to use, attempts to use or conspires to use or 15 16 who makes readily accessible to others, a hoax weapon of 17 destruction with the intent to deceive or otherwise mislead another person into believing that the hoax weapon of 18 19 destruction will cause terror, bodily harm or property 20 damage is guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment 21 for not more than five (5) years, and should physical 22 injury result, punishable by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) years, and if death results, shall be punished by 23 24 life imprisonment.

2 (c) This section does not apply to any member or 3 employee of the Armed Forces of the United States, a 4 federal or state governmental agency or a private entity 5 who is otherwise engaged in lawful activity within the scope of his employment, if the person is otherwise duly 6 7 authorized or licensed to manufacture, possess, sell, deliver, display, or is otherwise engaged in activity 8 9 relative to this section and if the person is in compliance 10 with applicable federal and state law.

(d) As used in this section:

(i) "Biological agent" means any microorganism,
virus, infectious substance, or biological product that may
be engineered through biotechnology, or any naturally
occurring or bioengineered component of any such
microorganism, virus, infectious substance or biological
product, capable of causing:

21 (A) Death, disease or other biological 22 malfunction in a human, an animal, a plant or other living 23 organism;

1 (B) Deterioration of food, water,

2 equipment, supplies or material of any kind; or

3

4 (C) Deleterious alteration of the

5 environment.

7 (ii) "Delivery system" means:

8

9 (A) Any apparatus, equipment, device, or

10 means of delivery specifically designed to deliver or

11 disseminate a biological agent, toxin or vector; or

12

13 (B) Any vector.

14

15 (iii) "Hoax weapon of destruction" means any

16 device or object that by its design, construction, content

17 or characteristics appears to be or to contain, or is

18 represented to be, constitute or contain, a weapon of

19 destruction, but which is, in fact, an inoperative

20 facsimile, imitation, counterfeit or representation of a

21 weapon of destruction which does not meet the definition of

22 a weapon of destruction or which does not actually contain

23 or constitute a weapon, biological agent, toxin, vector or

24 delivery system prohibited by this section;

2 (iv) "Toxin" means the toxic material of plants,

3 animals, microorganisms, viruses, fungi or infectious

4 substances, or a recombinant molecule, whatever its origin

5 or method of reproduction, including:

6

7 (A) Any poisonous substance or biological

8 product that may be engineered through biotechnology

9 produced by a living organism; or

10

11 (B) Any poisonous isomer or biological

12 product, homologue or derivative of such substance.

13

14 (v) "Vector" means a living organism or

15 molecule, including a recombinant molecule or biological

16 product that may be engineered through biotechnology,

17 capable of carrying a biological agent or toxin to a host;

18

19 (vi) "Weapon of destruction" means:

20

21 (A) Any device or object that is designed

22 or intended to cause death or serious bodily injury through

23 the release, dissemination, or impact of toxic or poisonous

24 chemicals or their precursors;

2 (B) Any device or object involving a

3 disease organism; or

4

5 (C) Any device or object that is designed

6 to release radiation or radioactivity at a level dangerous

7 to human life.

8

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

12 Constitution.
