6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 15-1-107(a)(i) and 22-23-103 are
9	amended to read:

11	15-1-107. Vacancies in offices; grounds; how filled.

13	(a) A vacancy exists in the office of mayor or
14	councilman if during the term for which elected any mayor
15	or councilman:

1 (i) Except as provided in W.S. 22-23-103, fails 2 the residency requirements as defined by local ordinance 3 for the city, town or ward; 4 5 22-23-103. Division of city into wards; residency. 6 7 (a) A city may be divided into wards by ordinance of the governing body of the city. The wards shall be compact 8 9 in form and as nearly equal in population as possible. 10 11 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this 12 section, a person shall not be a candidate for the council 13 from a ward for the purpose of meeting residency 14 requirements for the city ward, unless he has been a resident of that ward for at least one (1) year next 15 16 preceding his election. 17 18 (c) In any general election year in which city wards 19 are redrawn but not enacted into law at least one (1) year 20 prior to the applicable filing periods, a person may be a 21 candidate for a ward if he: 22

1	(i) Is a resident of the city on the date he
2	files an application under W.S. 22-5-204 or a petition
3	under W.S. 22-5-301; and
4	
5	(ii) Has been a resident of the city for at
6	least one (1) year next preceding his election.
7	
8	(d) A person seeking election from a ward as provided
9	under subsection (c) of this section, including a
10	councilman whose term otherwise would expire as a result of
11	completing his term of office, shall be a resident of the
12	ward at the time he takes office.
13	
14	(e) Following the redrawing of ward boundaries, a
15	councilman whose term of office does not expire following
16	the next general election shall continue to serve until the
17	completion of his term.
18	
19	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
20	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
21	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
22	Constitution.
