A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public lands; establishing specified  
2 lands as a state park to be known as the Wyoming Veterans'  
3 Memorial Museum; providing for administration of the area;  
4 and providing for an effective date.

13 **36-8-1301. Description and declaration of Wyoming**  
14 **Veterans' Memorial Museum.**

1           (a) The lands in Natrona county described as follows  
2 are hereby declared to be a state park: a parcel of land  
3 situate in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
4 Section 20, Township 34 North, Range 80 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M.,  
5 Natrona county, Wyoming, said parcel being more  
6 particularly described as follows: commencing at the  
7 southeast corner of said Section 20, monumented by a brass  
8 cap; thence N01°27'16"W, a distance of 2597.39 feet to the  
9 southeast corner of the parcel monumented by a nail and  
10 being the point of beginning; thence S43°17'47"W, a distance  
11 of 163.93 feet to the southwest corner of the parcel,  
12 monumented by a nail; thence N46°42'21"W, a distance of  
13 359.92 feet to the northwest corner of the parcel,  
14 monumented by a nail; thence N43°17'47"E, a distance of  
15 163.93 feet to the northeast corner of the parcel,  
16 monumented by a nail; thence S46°42'21"E, a distance of  
17 359.92 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.35  
18 acres, more or less.

20           (b) The state park shall be known as the Wyoming  
21 Veterans' Memorial Museum.
