A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; providing for
- 2 distribution of sales and use tax as specified; and
- 3 providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-15-111(b)(i) and (iii)(intro) and
- 8 39-16-111(b)(i) and (iii)(intro) are amended to read:

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10 **39-15-111.** Distribution.

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- 12 (b) Revenues earned under W.S. 39-15-104 during each
- 13 fiscal year shall be recognized as revenue during that
- 14 fiscal year for accounting purposes. Revenue collected by
- 15 the department under W.S. 39-15-104 shall be transferred to
- 16 the state treasurer who shall:

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2 (i) Until June 30, 2004 2003, subject to 3 subsection (g) of this section, credit seventy and one-half 4 percent (70.5%) and thereafter sixty-nine percent (69%) to 5 the state general fund except as provided by subsections (c) and (d) of this section; 6 7 (iii) From the remaining share, until June 30, 8 9 2004 2003, deduct an amount equivalent to one-half percent (0.5%) and thereafter deduct an amount equivalent to one 10 percent (1%) of the tax collected under W.S. 39-15-104. 11 12 From this amount, the state treasurer shall distribute 13 until June 30, 2004 2003, twenty thousand dollars 14 (\$20,000.00) and thereafter forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) annually to each county in equal monthly 15 installments and then distribute the remainder to each 16 17 county in the proportion that the total population of the county bears to the total population of the state. The 18 balance shall then be paid monthly to the treasurers of the 19 20 counties, cities and towns for payment into their 21 respective general funds. The percentage of the balance

From this amount, the state treasurer shall distribute

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until June 30, $\frac{2004-2003}{2000}$, five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) 2 3 and thereafter ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) annually 4 to each county in equal monthly installments and then 5 distribute the remainder to each county in the proportion that the total population of the county bears to the total 6 population of the state. The remainder shall then be paid 7 monthly to the treasurers of the counties, cities and towns 8 9 for payment into their respective general funds. The

10 percentage of the remainder that will be distributed to

11 each county and its cities and towns will be determined by

12 computing the percentage that net use taxes collected

13 attributable to vendors in each county including its cities

14 and towns bear to total net use taxes collected of vendors

15 in all counties including their cities and towns. The

16 distribution shall be as follows:
