Necessary small schools.

A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION relating to the provision of public  
2 schools.

3  
4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,  
5 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting  
6 separately, concurring therein:

8 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming  
9 Constitution, Article 7, Section 1 is proposed for  
10 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the  
11 next general election for approval or rejection to become  
12 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a  
13 majority of the electors at the election:

14  
15 **Article 7, Section 1. Legislature to provide for**  
16 **public schools; provision for necessary small schools.**

1       (a) The legislature shall provide for the  
2 establishment and maintenance of a complete and uniform  
3 system of public instruction, embracing free elementary  
4 schools of every needed kind and grade, a university with  
5 such technical and professional departments as the public  
6 good may require and the means of the state allow, and such  
7 other institutions as may be necessary.

9       (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section or  
10 any other provision of this constitution, the legislature  
11 may as it deems appropriate, define by law and fund  
12 necessary small public schools. Such funding shall not be  
13 subject to nor considered in any uniformity requirement for  
14 the system of public instruction.

15

16       **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse  
17 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

18

1 The adoption of this amendment authorizes the legislature  
2 to provide for necessary small public schools as it  
3 determines appropriate including the establishment of such  
4 funding levels and grade configurations as the legislature  
5 deems necessary and appropriate for small schools.
