A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the correctional industries program;  
2 amending requirements relating to the use of inmates in the  
3 program; amending provisions for location, ownership and  
4 leasing of facilities used in the program; eliminating the  
5 competitive bid process for facilities built for use in the  
6 program; and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 25-13-104 is amended to read:

12 **25-13-104. Agreements with private employers; leases.**

13

14 The department, in consultation with the correctional  
15 industries advisory board, may establish programs for the  
16 employment of inmates by private employers and enter into

1 agreements with private employers under which the employer  
2 owns, constructs, leases to or from the department or  
3 otherwise establishes facilities ~~within the exterior~~  
4 ~~boundaries of any state correctional facility~~ to  
5 manufacture or process goods or conduct any other business,  
6 commercial or agricultural enterprise and employ inmates ~~at~~  
7 ~~the~~ from a correctional facility. Facilities established  
8 under this section may be located within or outside the  
9 exterior boundaries of a state correctional facility  
10 property. Construction of ~~all~~ facilities by private  
11 employers under this section shall not be ~~competitively~~  
12 subject to competitive bid ~~and performed under W.S.~~  
13 ~~27-4-401 through 27-4-413~~ requirements applicable to  
14 construction by the state. Inmate labor may be used  
15 pursuant to W.S. 7-16-202 for construction of facilities  
16 that occurs within the exterior boundaries of a state  
17 correctional facility property under this section.

19 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
