A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to equalize the tax
treatment of employer-provided and individually purchased
health insurance by creating a tax credit for the full
amount of insurance purchased by individuals.

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6 WHEREAS, the high cost of health insurance has created a 7 large number of uninsured citizens in the United States and 8 the State of Wyoming;

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10 WHEREAS, those without health insurance are less likely to 11 receive adequate health care;

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13 WHEREAS, insurance purchasing decisions are to a large 14 extent made by employers and not insurance beneficiaries; 15

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1	WHEREAS, overreliance on employer-provided health insurance
2	impedes worker mobility;
3	
4	WHEREAS, spiraling health care costs are to some extent
5	caused by a lack of consumer participation in health care
6	markets, determined by third parties;
7	
8	WHEREAS, employers can deduct the full cost of employee
9	health insurance as a business expense, while individuals
10	may not.
11	
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
13	LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:
14	
15	Section 1. That the Wyoming State Legislature
16	petitions the Congress of the United States to equalize the
17	tax treatment of employer-provided and individually
18	purchased health insurance by creating a tax credit for the
19	full amount of insurance purchased by individuals.
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1 Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming 2 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the 3 United States, to the President of the Senate and the 4 Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United 5 States Congress and to the Wyoming Congressional 6 Delegation.
