## for

1 AN ACT relating to flags; authorizing the continued use of 2 the POW/MIA flag at the state capitol; providing for the 3 display of the POW/MIA flag at other state government 4 offices and buildings; allowing the use of the flag for 5 other government buildings and offices; specifying 6 legislative intent; and providing for an effective date. 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 8-3-118 is created to read: 10 11 12 8-3-118. POW/MIA flags. 13 14 (a) The National League of Families POW/MIA flag, 15 recognized by the United States Congress in P.L. 101-355

1 and other federal laws, is authorized and shall continue to 2 be displayed directly beneath the national flag on state 3 capitol grounds. All other state leased or owned buildings 4 and offices that fly the national flag may also fly the 5 POW/MIA flag directly beneath the national flag on any day upon which the national flag is displayed. Any state 6 7 agency, board or commission having authority for the supervision, control or management of a state leased or 8 9 owned building or office is authorized to adopt rules 10 relating to the display of the POW/MIA flag at the state 11 leased or owned building or office pursuant to this section. 12

14 (b) Any county, city, town or political subdivision of the state may display the POW/MIA flag directly beneath 15 16 the national flag on any day upon which the national flag 17 is displayed.

19 (c) All protocols used in displaying national flags 20 shall be used in displaying the POW/MIA flag. All 21 penalties provided by the laws of this state for the misuse 22 of the national flag are applicable to the POW/MIA flag.

(d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to 1 2 require the acquisition, erection and maintenance of a 3 flagpole or the display of the POW/MIA flag where a pole or 4 display of the national flag does not already exist.

5

6 Section 2. The intent of this act is to remember all 7 Wyomingites who have been or who may be listed as prisoners of war or missing in action as well as to express the 8 9 state's concern and commitment to these individuals and 10 their families. The display of the POW/MIA flag shall serve as a daily reminder of the state's concern and 11 12 commitment to help resolve the fates of these persons.

14 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
