A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to liquefied petroleum gas containers;  
2 making certain acts relating to liquefied petroleum gas  
3 containers unlawful; providing penalties; and providing for  
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-10-410 is created to read:

9

10 **35-10-410. Liquefied petroleum gas containers;**  
11 **unlawful acts; penalty.**

13 (a) No person other than the owner of a liquefied  
14 petroleum gas container or a person authorized by the owner  
15 of the container shall:

16

1           (i) Sell, barter, exchange, deliver or otherwise  
2 permit to be delivered the liquefied petroleum gas  
3 container;

4  
5           (ii) Dismantle, evacuate, service, install,  
6 fill, refill, tamper with or otherwise use in any manner  
7 the liquefied petroleum gas container; or

8  
9           (iii) Deface, erase, obliterate, remove,  
10 conceal, cover up or otherwise change any part of the  
11 container bearing the name or other identification of the  
12 lawful owner of the container or the manufacturer's  
13 specifications concerning the container.

14  
15           (b) This section shall not apply to portable  
16 containers constructed in compliance with federal  
17 regulations that have less than two hundred thirty-nine  
18 (239) pounds of water capacity and that are capable of  
19 storing liquefied petroleum gas.

20  
21           (c) A violation of subsection (a) of this section is  
22 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than  
23 six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty  
24 dollars (\$750.00), or both.

2 (d) For the purposes of this section, "liquefied  
3 petroleum gas" means as defined by W.S. 40-7-102(a)(xiii).

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
